## Cyber-attacks on European subsidiary of Daihatsu Diesel (The 2<sup>nd</sup> report)

As reported in our previous press release on 16<sup>th</sup> of May, an internal system failure due to unauthorised access occurred at an European subsidiary company of the Daihatsu Diesel Group.

We would like to provide an update on the current situation on this incident.

In addition to the network and system shutdown measures, the European subsidiary company found that there has been no further damage based on an investigation and analysis conducted by external cyber security experts and system support companies. We have resumed normal operations after implementing enhanced security measures as part of its preventative measures.

We will continue to investigate and analyse some of the data that may have been leaked, and if any affected data subjects are identified, we will take prompt action, with cooperation with local authorities.

We have also confirmed that there has been no damage to other companies of the Daihatsu Diesel Group.

Further announcements would be made through the website as soon as new information is available.

We would like to express our sincere apologies for the inconvenience and concern caused to our customers and other stakeholders.
