

Participation in the University of Tokyo's "Maritime Digital Engineering" Social Collaboration Program

DAIHATSU DIESEL MFG. CO., LTD. is participating in the University of Tokyo's Maritime and Ocean Digital Engineering (MODE) social collaboration program.

MODE was established at the Graduate School of Frontier Sciences, The University of Tokyo on October 1, 2022, to address the issues faced by the Japanese maritime industry, such as “development of new technologies and their social implementation in the global trend toward decarbonization”, “introduction of automated vessels to improve safety and work styles to maintain shipping services,” and “ensuring overwhelming productivity in the increasingly sophisticated ship design and manufacturing processes.”

We will cooperate with MODE's efforts to create a center for research, social implementation, and human resource development for decarbonisation and automation in the maritime sector, contributing to the realisation of sustainable maritime logistics through research and development of next-generation fuel and energy saving vessels.
